ESPACIOS INTERMEDIOS

Paola Dávila & Ilán Rabchinsky

Esta muestra conjuga un diálogo entre dos autores contemporáneos con preocupaciones estéticas allegadas. En imágenes abstractas que discurren sobre el tiempo o el espacio, **Paola Dávila** e **Ilán Rabchinskey** evidencian largos procesos de producción y reflexión. Estas investigaciones visuales llevaron a los artistas a ser seleccionados para formar parte de la **XIX Bienal de Fotografía del Centro de la Imagen** (abierta hasta el 27 de marzo de 2022). Espacios Intermedios articula de forma más extensa su trabajo, al tiempo que lo celebra.

Los acercamientos de cada uno son distintos, así como los resultados, sin embargo en ambos se percibe una preocupación por las posibilidades de la imagen fotográfica como un campo abierto de percepción, donde los límites espaciales se vuelven difusos en una especie de metáfora abierta sobre la cual caminar.

This exhibition combines a dialogue between two contemporary authors with related aesthetic concerns. In abstract images that flow over time or space, **Paola Dávila** and **Ilán Rabchinskey** show long processes of production and reflection. These visual investigations led the artists to be selected as part of the **XIX Photography Biennial of the Centro de la Imagen** (open until March 27, 2022). Espacios Intermedios articulates their work more extensively, while celebrating it.

The approaches of each one are different, as well as the results, however in both a concern for the possibilities of the photographic image is perceived as an open field of perception, where the spatial limits become diffuse in a kind of open metaphor on which one can walk.

















Paola Dávila
Mexico, 1980

Born in Oaxaca, Mexico, she studied Visual Arts at the National School of Plastic Arts, UNAM from 1998 to 2002, in that same year she entered the contemporary painting seminar taught by teacher Ignacio Salazar. From 1999 to 2015, she attended various theory and photography workshops.

For several years, she has generated various visual statements from photography. Beyond the self-imposed limits in thematic terms (the house, for example), this exercise has allowed her to articulate concerns and situate spaces: inside, outside, the limits between one and the other.

Paola Dávila's work has been presented in nine individual exhibitions and more than 30 collective exhibitions both in Mexico and abroad. She has received several awards and scholarships throughout her career. In 2021, she was the recipient of the Acquisition Award of the XIX Photography Biennial of the Centro de la Imagen. Since 2020 she is a member of the National System of Art Creators, FONCA, CONACULTA.

Collections · Paola Dávila's work belongs to private and public collections such as the Tierney Foundation, Chopo Museum, UNAM, Institute of Culture of Yucatán, El Carmen Museum, Libertad Art Gallery, Phillips Collection and the National Photo Library, INAH.

Paola Dávila
México, 1980

Nace en Oaxaca, México y estudia la carrera de Artes Visuales en la Escuela Nacional de Artes Plásticas, UNAM de 1998 a 2002, en ese mismo año entra al seminario de pintura contemporánea impartido por el maestro Ignacio Salazar. De 1999 a 2015 cursa diversos talleres de teoría y fotografía.

Desde hace varios años ha generado diversos enunciados visuales desde la fotografía. Más allá de los límites autoimpuestos en términos temáticos (la casa, por ejemplo), dicho ejercicio le ha permitido articular preocupaciones y situar espacios: adentro, afuera, los límites entre uno y otro.

El trabajo de Paola Dávila se ha presentado en nueve exposiciones individuales y más de 30 exposiciones colectivas tanto en México como el extranjero. Ha recibido varios premios y becas a lo largo de su carrera. En el 2021 fue acreedora del Premio de adquisición de la XIX Bienal de Fotografía del Centro de la Imagen. Desde el 2020 es miembro del Sistema Nacional de Creadores de Arte, FONCA, CONACULTA.

Ilán Rabchinskey is a Mexican photographer and educator. Among other themes, his work explores the tension between the forces of nature and the human species, the physical constitution of matter, and the dynamics between objects and images.

He has exhibited in Mexico, France, England, the United States, Spain, Chile and Brazil, and has been invited to artist residencies in Tokyo Japan (Casa Nano, 2019), Fiskars Finland (ONOMA AiR, 2018), Oaxaca Mexico (Casa Wabi, 2016) and Chiapas Mexico (Dedazo Artist Residency, 2017). He has received several awards and grants, and has been featured in numerous international publications.

Ilán travels frequently but is based in Mexico City where he sporadically teaches a project development workshop. In 2020 he was awarded Mexico's prestigious National Endowment for the Arts SNCA three year grant. In 2021 he was selected for the Centro de la Imagen XIX Photography Biennial.

Publications · He has published four photo books: "Piedra Fundacional" (Muga, 2019, Spain), "El Medio Terrestre" (Artes de Mexico, 2016, Mexico) "Remolino de Tierra" (Ediciones Acapulco, 2014, Mexico), and "Yo'tan K'op Corazón de la Palabra" (Trilce, 2009, Mexico).

México, 1980

Ilán Rabchinskey es artista y educador. Entre otros temas, su trabajo explora la tensión entre las fuerzas naturales y la especie humana, las propiedades de la materia, y la intersección entre fotografía y escultura.

Recientemente ha sido invitado a residencias en Tokyo (Casa Nano) y Finlandia (ONOMA AiR). Ha expuesto en México, Francia, Inglaterra, Estados Unidos, España, Brasil y Chile. Ilán ha recibido varios premios y reconocimientos, y su trabajo ha sido publicado en numerosos medios internacionales. En 2021, fue seleccionado para la XIX Bienal de Fotografía del Centro de la Imagen.

Además de su práctica, Ilán es profesor de fotografía en universidad Centro y miembro del Sistema Nacional de Creadores de Arte FONCA.

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
